The Medical Village will directly address Ontario County's need for greater access to providers of primary care, behavioral health services and specialty medical services. It also sets into motion critical modernization that will enhance the patient experience and give our outstanding hospital staff more of what they need to deliver outstanding care.

Our vision to dramatically transform the delivery of healthcare in the Finger Lakes Region was jumpstarted by a \$25.5 million New York State grant, through our affiliation with Rochester Regional Health. However, with a total project cost of \$32 million, we need to make up that gap through philanthropic support. Your gifts will help us fully realize this vision. This is a truly pivotal moment in the hospital's lifetime and a major step forward, one that we need to take together.

Medical Village Highlights

- 50,000 square feet of renovated, re-purposed space
- Centralized services and a hub for outpatient care
- New programs: dental care, pulmonary services and women's health
- Expanded programs: behavioral health, cardiac rehabilitation, mammography, pulmonary medicine, physical therapy and rehabilitation, primary care, respiratory care and vascular surgery


Your Support Matters
