Second Floor—Surgical Care

We're creating exceptional space for exceptional care providers. Our surgeons and nurses have been performing at an incredibly high level despite limited facilities. Soon they will have 20 new multi-disciplinary operating rooms equipped with technology that matches and magnifies their skill level, allowing us to provide the highest level of care to more patients. The Sands-Constellation Center for Critical Care will put us at the forefront of surgical care and establishes a model of quality for our entire system.





With more than 20,000 annual cases, Rochester General has the system's busiest operating rooms and is often running at maximum capacity. Our new surgical floor will not only enable us to do more for our community, but it will also give the community access to a facility that rivals or surpasses those found at hospitals larger in size.

Third Floor—Women's Health and Newborn Care

We're already recognized as a Center of Excellence in Minimally Invasive (Robotic) Gynecology and the first in New York to be a Certified Quality Breast Center of Excellence. Our new facility positions us to garner further distinction. We will be offering mothers and newborns 20 private rooms in the Postpartum Suite and 14 private rooms in the adjacent Rochester General Hospital Association Twigs Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, ultimately providing a broader range of care as well as more space and comfort.



Promoting and protecting the future of our community begins with the care of our smallest and most fragile patients and those who will look after them. That's why we have made a significant investment in our ability to aid in advancing the quest for better care for infants and their mothers in the Rochester community.




Your Support Matters

Fifth, Sixth & Eighth Floors—Patient-Centric Care

Floor Highlights

- 36 private patient rooms per floor (108 total), featuring patient, family, and caregiver "zones"
- Acuity-adaptable rooms that allow for progressive and critical care in the same setting
- Large, comfortable waiting areas for visitors on each floor

First Floor

Serves as the welcome point for the center, with public spaces for visitors and families, as well as elevator access.

- A new **café** provides a convenient location for a meal or just a place to sit and relax.
- An open atrium connects the new building with the existing hospital and serves as a comfortable commons area.

Second Floor

A new state-of-the-art surgical center provides a better-equipped and more flexible system to handle interdisciplinary procedures.

- The **operating suite** consists of 20 operating rooms designed for various procedures, including orthopaedic, vascular, spine, neurological, gynecological and general surgery, among others.
- An adjacent **post-anesthesia care unit** (PACU) includes 28 private patient bays with extensive nurse support.

Third Floor

Collocated neonatal and maternity services provide vital care for babies and new mothers.

■ The **RGHA Twigs Neonatal Intensive Care Unit** includes 14 private rooms for babies that provide more space and comfort for families, while enhancing infection control.

■ The **postpartum suite** has 20 private rooms designed to ensure a family-centered environment around mother and baby.

Fifth, Sixth & Eighth Floors

The patient bed floors (configured identically) feature a total of 108 private, acuity-adaptable rooms that allow for progressive and critical care in the same setting, resulting in better patient outcomes and greater efficiency.

36 private patient rooms per floor, each with patient, family, and caregiver "zones" to enhance quality of care and comfort.

 Large, comfortable waiting areas are located on each floor.
