



MODERNIZING RADIOLOGY IN GENESEE COUNTY

A LIFE-SAVING INVESTMENT: When you give in support of the radiology department at United Memorial Medical Center, you're ensuring that your friends and neighbors have access to the best radiologists and *the best imaging technology – so they have the best chance for healing.*

AN INCREASING NEED: For years, UMMC has offered outstanding care while making do with exam rooms that are uncomfortably small and an MRI machine that's more than 20 years old and sits inside a makeshift trailer. Right-sizing and upgrading the equipment in the radiology department means patients and their medical teams will benefit from better imaging and less radiation. Plus, visitors will have easier, more direct access to the department, which treats a growing number of patients each year.

In fact, more than 20,000 people a year visit the emergency department. Another 22,000 receive treatment through Genesee Orthopaedics, and many of those patients rely on the radiology department at UMMC.

“State-of-the-art technology helps attract patients – and talented physicians and medical teams,” said Daniel P. Ireland, BSN, president of UMMC. “People who live near Batavia want access to a high-quality radiology department close to where they live and work.”

A STATE-OF-THE-ART APPROACH: Expanding and updating equipment in the radiology department will cost **\$11 million**. The expansion will be completed by the end of 2021, and renovations will be completed by the end of 2022.
