To ensure that your bequest intentions are used correctly, we suggest using the following language in your plans:

For a specific bequest

“I give and devise to Rochester Regional Health (EIN 22-2229425), located at 330 Monroe Ave, Suite 400, Rochester, NY 14607, the sum of \$_____ (or asset) to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or program).”

For a residuary bequest

“I give and devise to Rochester Regional Health (EIN 22-2229425), located at 330 Monroe Ave, Suite 400, Rochester, NY 14607, all (or state a percentage) of the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or program).”
